



PORTUGAL

With year round sunshine and excellent off-season access through Faro airport, the Algarve region in southern Portugal is famous for its world-class golf courses offering a mix of challenging championship courses and stunning coastal views with Vilamoura, Quinta do Lago, and Vale do Lobo all familiar to Irish golfers. Overall 31 of Portugal's 75 golf courses are in the Algarve.

Elsewhere in Portugal the Porto region offers five fantastic courses such as Vidago Palace Golf Course, Amarante Golf Course, and Estela Golf Club.

Estela Golf Course is just 15 minutes from Porto Airport, where Atlantic sea breezes test players' skills, making each stroke a memorable moment. The course also offers personalised lessons with experienced instructor Luis Cameira, allowing players to enhance their skills.

Axis Golf Ponte de Lima founded in 1995, is located about 70 km from Porto airport, an 18-hole course with a par 71 across 6005 metres, famously offering hilly holes, the first 9 being hilly and the second nine level.

Golfers can enjoy fantastic views over the Lima valley and experience the charm of the Minho countryside. Nearby accommodation options include the AXIS Ponte de Lima Golf Resort Hotel and The Manor House "Casa do Anquião". Nearby facilities include horse riding and other activities.

Memorable golf opportunities in the Lisbon region include Villa Real, Penha Longa, Troia Golf, and Oitavos Dunes. Lisbon's proximity to the capital city and its airport adds to its appeal, allowing golfers to combine their sporting adventures with cultural experiences.

The beautiful island of Madeira hosts remarkable golf courses such as Palheiro Golf and Santo da Serra, two exceptional courses known for their breath-taking mountain and ocean views.

SOUTH AFRICA

Fancourt Golf Estate in George, Western Cape stands out as a premier golf resort in South Africa featuring three world-class courses, including the highly acclaimed links course.

Durban Country Club along the Indian Ocean coastline is one of South Africa's oldest and most prestigious golf courses, renowned for its scenic beauty, it offers challenging fairways, lush vegetation, and breath-taking views with its signature, the par-five third hole particularly renowned for its difficulty.

SPAIN

Spain is the leading golf destination in Europe with more than 430 golf courses and the second worldwide, with Irish golfers making up approximately 10pc of the total market.

So familiar and popular is Spain in the Irish market that golfers refer to the Costa del Sol as the Costa del Golf, with many returning to play the courses year after year, availing of the sunshine and excellent low season access through the many gateway airports.

The sun-soaked region of Andalucía, wrapped along the south coast, is home to over 100 golf courses spread across its eight provinces, with Malaga and Cadiz having the highest concentration of courses. It is not just the golfers but their partners and companions who return to enjoy the sunshine and the activities. RORY WINS RACE TO DUBAI

Rory McIlroy fired an ominous warning to his DP World Tour rivals as he insisted he has at least another ten years left at the very top after winning his fifth Harry Vardon Trophy.

The Northern Irishman won the 2023 Race to Dubai with a week to spare in a season that has seen him win two Rolex Series events, secure three top tens in Major Championships and miss just one cut on the DP World Tour.

Adding to his victories in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2022, he is now third on the all-time list, just one short of the late, great Seve Ballesteros and three behind the record of Colin Montgomerie.

And the 34-year-old insists he has no intention of slowing down as he looks to add to his five Rankings titles, 16 DP World Tour wins and four Major Championships.

"I've still got a little bit left in the tank," he said after his final round at the DP World Tour Championship. "I think I've still got a good eight to ten years left in me where I can play at the top, top level.

"I'd like to think that I'm going to challenge, at least try to get past Seve and then sort of try to get past Monty as well. But it's certainly a goal of mine for the rest of my career to do something like that. It would mean a lot to me.

"I think it shows my consistency year-to-year. I think over the last ten years, I think I've won eight season-long titles between America and between here, so it just shows my level of consistency.

"I said to Harry (Diamond, caddie) on the last green, there's a few guys that are able to beat me sort of one week or the next week but I don't think there's a lot of people that can beat me throughout the entire season.

"It's just about trying to be a little more clinical when I get to those weeks where I have chances to win.

"Overall, it's been another really solid year. Stroke average has been great and I've played really good golf, really consistent. Hopefully more of the same going into next year and beyond."

The Dane headed into the final day in a tie for 21st place after rounds of 71-67-72 on the first three days at Dromoland Castle.

But Soenderby fired the round of her life – a 62 (-10) – to post the clubhouse lead and was later joined by Sweden's Lisa Pettersson and Anne Van Dam of the Netherlands.

The trio headed back to the 18th hole for the playoff where the 23-year-old reached the green in two and sunk her eagle putt to secure her maiden title on the Ladies European Tour (LET).

"I'm not quite sure what happened in the playoff! I hit a good drive," said the newest LET winner. "It was a very long drive compared to the first round there.

"Then I had 178 and just wanted to hit a 5-iron to the middle of the green and missed it a bit left. It sounded like I almost holed it and then the putt went in. I didn't think my score was enough when I got into the clubhouse, but it turned out to be enough.

"It is redemption, after the 18th last year I said I'm okay to not be in the playoff because I'm not sure I'm ready to

"It wasn't my best ball-striking ever at all, I maybe hit two good shots striking wise. I was just in play from the tee, and I hit them onto the greens, and I hit some good putts and out of nowhere I was 10-under.

"I love this place, it's probably my favourite place to be. I was really looking forward to it, I was very calm and just happy all week. I knew I could score low as well and I knew it was coming today."

As the Dane approached 18 green in her final round, she thought about last year's tournament where she made a three-putt and missed out on an opportunity to win, however it was a different story this time around.

She added: "When I hit it up in the front of the green on 18, it was similar to last year and I hit it in the fringe, and I've really been comfortable with hitting from the fringe. My speed was perfect on that one, but I had my coach's voice in the back of my head."

It was a good day for Sweden's Pettersson who had an eagle, four birdies and two bogeys on her scorecard for a round of 68 (-4) and also post a total of 16-under-par.

In the playoff, Pettersson also found the green in two but her second shot rolled down the back of the green and she was unable to make her eagle or birdie putts.

Dutch star Van Dam held a three-shot lead going into the final round but had an up and down day with four bogeys and five birdies on her card for a 71 (-1) but one of those birdies came at the last to make it a three-way playoff.

However, on the way to the playoff Van Dam's bag got caught under a gallery rope and fell off the buggy which led to her driver shaft snapping.

Despite that, the five-time LET winner still made the most of the playoff hole hitting the green in two and just missed her eagle putt which would have forced another hole.

While Leona Maguire's presence brought big crowds for the weekend 2023 was not to be. No doubt the Cavan Lady will have her day in the sun at the flagship Irish event.

And to Dromoland, huge kudos for again successfully hosting one of the finest tournaments on the Ladies European Tour this season. Carton House in County Kildare awaits in 2024.

EUROPE REGAIN THE RYDER CUP

Europe defeated the United States comprehensively 16½-11½ to regain the Ryder Cup and ensure their unbeaten run on home soil will continue to 34 years.

Tommy Fleetwood was the man to secure the vital point on a dramatic afternoon at Marco Simone Golf & Country Club where, despite Europe entering the singles with a commanding lead and never trailing, the U.S. threatened to complete a remarkable comeback.

The home side led 10½-5½ on Sunday morning, meaning the U.S. Team needed the biggest Ryder Cup comeback in history to win despite a rousing 3-1 session victory in Saturday afternoon's foursomes.

Early European success got the home side to 14-7 but Matt Fitzpatrick missed an 18-footer on the last for the trophy as the Americans cut the gap to 14-11.

Fleetwood and Shane Lowry then both guaranteed at least half a point each before Fleetwood won the 17th

and they gave me everything. They trusted me and they delivered for me.

"Our guys got off to a great start, the early guys which is what we needed. Wanted some blue on the board early and then a few matches changed to red and you just kept looking at the board, kept looking at the board.

"This is the best (moment of my career). This is why the Ryder Cup is so special to me and to these guys because of these moments. We play for each other and we get to share in that success together and we get to spend this week together and we'll share those memories forever.

"Not many people gave us a chance after Whistling Straits. We were big underdogs. We started to show some form in the last six months and I couldn't be happier with

against Rickie Fowler to secure a 3&1 victory and put the Ryder Cup back in European hands.

European Captain Luke Donald - who was undefeated as a player in four Ryder Cups - was in tears after seeing Fleetwood and Lowry make sure of the half-points.

"I'm so emotional," he said. "It's been a long process, an amazing journey - I enjoyed this one.

"It was stressful, the U.S. put up a fight but I'm so proud of my 12 guys. We formed a strong bond from day one

the team I got. I think these guys will be around for a long time and we're going to put up a great fight in two years' time."

A 4-0 foursomes session victory for Europe on the first morning on Friday set the tone for the week and the home side led 9½-2½ after three sessions.

The U.S. fightback began as they took the Saturday four-balls and, while they managed a 6-6 tie across the singles, the mountain was too big to climb.

"If I have any reflection right now it's that you take your hat off and tip your cap to Team Europe and to Luke - they played great, they earned it and I was very impressed with them," said U.S. Captain Zach Johnson.

"We got outplayed but we showed grit, we showed heart and it got interesting there. We had some momentum coming into the day and even some momentum during the day so I'm proud of my guys. They fought, they've got so much heart and grit, it's not them, it's on me and maybe some poor decisions. I can reflect at some point, I don't have any idea yet but it's not about those 12 guys. They played so hard for each other and our country and I'm grateful for each and every one of them."

The Ryder Cup story moves to Bethpage Black in Long Island, New York for 2025 and two years later, the JP McManus owned Adare Manor Golf Resort in County Limerick will proudly host.

THE SOLHEIM CUP 2023

Europe retained The Solheim Cup in dramatic circumstances with a 14-14 tie against USA at Finca Cortesin in Spain.

Starting the day tied at 8-8, after two days of foursomes and fourballs, it all came down to an enthralling final day of singles and the teams tied the session with six points each.

Spanish star Carlota Ciganda holed the putt to win her match and secure the 14th point needed to retain the Cup, which meant that Europe claimed an historic three in a row.

Prior to this match, the overall scoreline was 10-7 in America's favour. Since the contest began in 1990, Europe had never won three competitions in a row. The US team won three in a row in '94, '96 and '98 and repeated the feat again in '05, '07 and '09.

European Captain Suzann Pettersen, who made the winning putt four years ago at Gleneagles, said: "I think the tears have gone now. I think it was meant to be, Carlota holing the winning putt in Spain. Hedwall played her part. It came down to the wire."

Hedwall was the player who changed the momentum for Europe. Three down after 12, she turned the match

around, winning five of the last six holes against Ally Ewing to clinch a crucial point.

Pettersen said: "It's going to be a big party tonight." When asked how she would celebrate, she added: "The Spanish way."

Here's how the final day unfolded...

Final Day Highlights

Leona Maguire v Rose Zhang

Leona Maguire won her singles match against Rose Zhang 4 and 3 and put the first point on the board for Europe.

In the second singles match, Zhang won the first hole. The first blue on the board appeared after Maguire's back-to-back birdies put the Irish star 1 up through 3 holes.

The American won the fourth, but Maguire made a long birdie putt to win the fifth and go 1 up again. Zhang won the par-3 sixth with a birdie and the match was back to all square before Maguire sank a par putt to win the seventh, go 1 up again.

Maguire won the 10th and 11th before Zhang took the 12th, but on the 13th, Zhang found the penalty area short of the green and then took too much club with her approach and was looking at a five. Maguire chipped to two feet in three and Zhang didn't threaten the hole so told Maguire to pick up her marker and she was back to 3 up.

On the next, Maguire then holed an enormous eagle putt uphill from 14 paces to go 4 Up after 14. Her par putt on 15 was conceded and Maguire drew first blood for Europe with her point taking the score to 8-9, putting Europe up for the first time.

Maguire said: "Jessica Korda tweeted the other day that I was annoying at match play, so the goal this week was to be as annoying as possible. Suzann made it very clear a couple of months ago that I would be playing five [matches] but I think with the energy of this crowd I could have played 10."

Megan Khang v Linn Grant

The first point on the board for the U.S. came courtesy of Megan Khang, who defeated Linn Grant 1 Up. Playing in the first match, Khang won the opening hole thanks to a birdie on the 299-yard par-4 first.

She led throughout the match and although Grant won the seventh and 12th holes, she handed two back at the 10th and 13th.

Grant holed a clutch birdie putt to win the 16th and was just one down, but, at 18, her eagle putt came up just short and Khang made a winning birdie putt from five feet to win 1 Up.

Danielle Kang v Charley Hull

Kang won the first hole, but Hull tied the match with a par on the third when Kang missed her putt from close range.

Kang won the sixth, eighth and ninth to go three up, and although Hull won the 10th, Kang went back to three in front thanks to a birdie on the 12th. Kang then won the 16th with a birdie for a comfortable 4 and 2 victory.

Anna Nordqvist v Jennifer Kupcho

Tied through three holes, a par on the fifth was good enough for Nordqvist to take the hole and put Europe 1 up. The European vice-captain also won the sixth and seventh to make it three holes in a row and go 3 Up. Kupcho won the eighth and 13th and 14th, but Nordqvist won the 12th and 16th to go 2 up.

On the 17th tee, Nordqvist fired her tee shot to the heart of the green and Kupcho mis-hit her iron under pressure. Nordqvist's putt for the match was conceded resulting in a 2&t1 victory for the playing Vice-Captain and taking the scores to 10-10.

Georgia Hall v Andrea Lee

In a closely fought match, Hall birdied the first hole to go 1 up. Lee won the sixth, Hall won the seventh and Lee won the eighth to bring the match back to level. Although Hall won the 12th and 14th holes, Lee won the 15th and Hall missed birdie chances on the 16th and 17th. The match ended in a tie and the score moved to 10 ½ each.

Lilia Vu v Madelene Sagström

World number two Vu, pointless up until the singles, had a statement to make and she holed a long putt from five yards on the first to go 1 up against

Carlota Ciganda v Nelly Korda

At the 299-yard par-4 first hole, world no.3 Korda, looking to silence the home crowd, played safe with an iron.

World no.28 Ciganda's tee shot at the first with a wood landed on the green and rolled over the back, but her chip to the green ran back down the hill. She made a par putt to tie the hole, but then won the second and third to go 2 up.

Korda won the ninth, 10th and 15th to tie the match. The American missed her birdie putt from five feet on 16 and Ciganda holed hers from three feet to go 1 Up. On the 17th, Ciganda hit the most magnificent tee shot to within four feet of the flag. Korda's ball ended off the green and her chip narrowly missed the hole. She made her par.

“It's going to be a big party tonight.” When asked how she would celebrate, she added: “The Spanish way ” – European Captain, Suzann Pettersen

Sagström. She won five of the first six holes with birdies to go 5 Up. Sagström fought back to win the eighth and 10th holes, but Vu won the 11th to get back to 4 Up. Sagström won the 13th but Vu closed the match on 15.

Angel Yin v Celine Boutier

World no.5 Boutier won the first to go 1 up, but Californian Yin was pumped, winning the second, third and seventh to go 2 Up.

Boutier won the eighth, 11th and 12th, but Yin won 13 and 14 to go 1 Up. Boutier won the 15th, but Yin won the 16th and 17th to take the point and the overall tally to 12 ½ – 10 ½ in favour of the USA.

Gemma Dryburgh v Cheyenne Knight

Scottish rookie Dryburgh holed an enormous putt from 20 yards to win the third hole and then took the fifth and sixth to go 3 up.

Dryburgh lost three holes at the eighth, 15th and 16th and suddenly the match was tied heading to 17. Ewing and Dryburgh matched each other's scores on 17 and 18 and the match ended in a tie, with the overall scores 13-11 in America's favour.

Caroline Hedwall v Ally Ewing

Ewing had the momentum and was 3 Up after 12. Three down with six to play, Hedwall won five of the last six holes to turn the match around in dramatic circumstances. The heroine of the 2013 Solheim Cup holed a monster putt at the 16th to take the match back to all square.

She then holed another perfectly judged birdie putt downhill on the par-3 17th to go 1 Up as a path to Europe potentially retaining the trophy opened up.

At the par-5 18th, Hedwall hit her second shot to the heart of the green. Ewing's second found the bunker and after her third shot, her ball ran over the green and down a bank. Her fourth shot ran well past the

After taking a deep breath, Ciganda made her putt to win her match 2&t1 and took Europe to the 14 points needed prompting jubilant scenes on the 17th green.

Lexi Thompson v Emily Kristine Pedersen

In the last match, Pedersen won the first and third holes, but Thompson fought back, winning six holes to get to 4 Up, before Pedersen won the 14th with a birdie to be 3 down.

Pedersen then won the 15th with a par after Thompson missed the hole, but 2 Up with two to play, Thompson won her match 2&t1 for the final score of 14-14.

HORIZON IRISH OPEN 2023

Vincent Norrman claimed a memorable victory at The K Club after a sparkling final round 65 secured a second DP World Tour title.

Vincent Norrman, 2023 Horizon Irish Open winner

Norrman began the day six shots off the lead but picked up six birdies in eight holes around the turn either side of a lengthy weather delay to surge into contention.

And after pulling off some valuable par saves over the closing holes, the Swede completed his round with a close-range birdie on the 18th to set the clubhouse target at 14 under par.

Norrman's victory continued a sensational fortnight for Swedish golf following Ludvig Åberg's victory at Omega European Masters. Germany's Long finished alone in second place on 13 under after birdieing the last to complete his final-round 72.

Home favourite Shane Lowry finished in a tie for third after his roller-coaster 68, alongside Ryan Fox, Grant Forrest and Thruston Lawrence.

Norrman started his fourth round with six straight pars before picking up his first birdie of the day from 12 feet on the seventh. He sank another birdie putt - this time from 20 feet at the ninth to get to nine under before play was suspended due to thunder and lightning for just over 90 mins.

When the action resumed, Norrman picked up where he left off, getting up and down from a bunker for birdie at the tenth before completing his hat-trick with an 18-foot putt on the next.

Two more lengthy birdie putts at the 13th and 14th saw Norrman reach 13 under, and he produced one of the best par saves of the week on the 16th to keep his card clean, getting up and down from the rough.

After paring the 17th from six feet, Norrman gave himself a long eagle try on the last but instead had to settle for a birdie and a 14-under-par tally.

With his title rivals as many as six holes behind him, Norrman went to the range to prepare for a possible play-off, but around 90 minutes after he had finished his round, he was finally able to celebrate victory as Long failed to make an eagle at the 18th.

Norrman was thrilled with his win, saying: "It means everything. Obviously such a cool event to play. The fans have been incredible. I've really had a fun week.

“Obviously if you win, you're doing something good. It's a world-class event, and honestly I can't believe it's happened”

That was good enough for a share of the lead at the time, but with a large chasing pack, which included World Number Two Rory McIlroy breathing down his neck several holes further back down the course, he faced an anxious wait to discover whether his total would be enough.

With third-round leader Hurlly Long who had been locked alongside Norrman when he finished his round slipping backwards on the stretch and no-one else able to get to 14 under, Norrman secured his second title of the 2023 season following his maiden triumph at the Barbasol Championship in July.

"The front nine was huge. I was playing so-so and then I birdied the seventh and ninth to get some momentum going into the back. I think that was key today. Obviously if you win, you're doing something good. It's a world-class event, and honestly I can't believe it's happened."

Speaking about how his Barbasol Championship victory less than two months previous helped him, he said: "I learned so much that day, probably the most I've ever done in my career. It's just golf at the end of the day, but obviously I love playing golf, and I'm having the time of my life out there."



Spain is a leading golf destination in Europe with around 300 days of sunshine each year. In this edition Irish Golf Review provides an overview of some recommended options.

INTRODUCTION

Marbella is the golf capital of Europe. It is located on the Costa del Sol, near Malaga, an area with numerous prestigious courses. In general, the south of Andalusia is highly appreciated by golf enthusiasts and there are many well-known clubs around Malaga and on the Costa de Luz (in Cadiz and Huelva). The Costa Brava area (in Catalonia), the Costa Cálida (in the Region of Murcia) and the Region of Valencia also have interesting options, in addition to the Canary and Balearic Islands.

Selection of Airports

The locations of the main golf areas are perfect if you want to organise a short trip, because they are close to airports with numerous international connections. Malaga, Alicante, Barcelona, Girona and Madrid airports are very close to major golf courses and make it possible to plan a getaway from almost any country in Europe.

Variety of Golf Courses

Depending on your tastes, your holiday destination, the circumstances... In Spain you can choose between very different golf courses throughout the whole country. You can find them overlooking the sea, in rural areas, amidst mountains, and even in big cities.

In Cantabria, you can even play in the Real Golf de Pedreña, where Spanish champion Severiano Ballesteros assisted in the design.

Golf for All

Spain hosts international tournaments and many professionals choose to train here. However, Spain also offers options for any amateur or first-time golfer. There are courses for very different levels and many clubs offer learning and practical courses for all ages.

Relaxation and Leisure

Another of the advantages offered by Spain is the fact that the days here have more hours of sunlight, meaning more time to enjoy. Theme parks, terraces, outdoor activities, concerts, theatre plays, etc. And when night falls, remember that in Spain you can keep having fun into the early hours of the morning with a wide range of restaurants, live music, bars and nightclubs.

Selected courses

Golf East Mallorca is a wonderful golf destination on Mallorca's East Coast. The area offers great golf courses and unique holiday accommodations with outstanding culinary and cultural experiences. 





Baixa is the city's traditional shopping district where visitors can stroll around the streets and find dozens of shops offering a wide range of temptations.

Rua Augusta is the main artery of the Baixa Pombalina leading north from Terreiro do Paço (known as Black Horse Square by the English), to the beautiful Praça do Rossio (Praça Dom Pedro V).

Chiado is a sophisticated hub for the city's young people, artists and intellectuals, it's an area of iconic cafés including "A Brasileira", art schools, theatres and of living history. The intrinsic beauty of Chiado, and its people – going about their daily lives – makes the area what it is.

Alfama is one of the oldest quarters in Lisbon. Since it largely survived the earthquake of 1755, the area still retains much of its original layout. Adjacent to Alfama are the likewise old quarters of Castelo and Mouraria, on the western and northern slopes of the hill that is crowned by St. George's Castle. Every year in June, the streets of all three quarters come alive with the feasts in honour of the popular saints. The Graça quarter and the churches of São Vicente de Fora and Santa Engrácia are within walking distance of this area.

Just north of Rossio, discover Avenida da Liberdade, which in the 19th century, was the favourite promenade for the Lisbon elite. Today, the Avenida is home to exclusive international boutiques to tempt and inspire.

Bairro Alto is one of the most characteristic and attractive neighbourhoods in the city. Bairro Alto boasts boutiques and bars and is a place where people meet in an eclectic and multicultural atmosphere. Traditional restaurants nestle alongside cosy bookshops; tea rooms serving signature cakes vie for attention with funky design shops and the boutiques of the most respected Portuguese fashion designers.

Santos – in this area you can find some of the most fashionable bars and discos. But also, restaurants, museums and a wide range of design shops.

Belém is linked to Portugal's Golden Age of Discoveries as the site where the famous navigators set sail to discover the world. Today it is a spacious green

suburb with many gardens, parks and monuments that are well worth a visit. Amongst Belém's attractions are the Jerónimos Monastery, the Monument to the Discoveries, Torre de Belém and Belém Cultural Centre.

The Parque das Nações is ideal for all ages. Located in the eastern part of Lisbon, this area is a focus of the city's cultural life. The gardens along the river, frame the facilities at the Parque, including the Pavilhão Atlântico, venue for events and the new Casino Lisboa.

The Oceanário is not to be missed, amazing young and old alike with the diversity of its collections. The Pavilhão do Conhecimento and the Vasco da Gama tower are other attractions in this unique park. Take a ride on the cable car offering breathtaking views of the river and the city.

From Nations Park to Belém – The riverside, is one of the favourite meeting places for the people of Lisbon. Families, friends and people of all ages enjoy the river views and the wide variety of places to walk and spend time with friends. Cafés terraces, bars and restaurants bustle with the hubbub of people enjoying themselves day and night.

Outside Lisbon

Estoril / Cascais : The Costa do Estoril is ripe for discovery. Romantic, cosmopolitan, packed with entertainment and boasting a unique character, Estoril is where Lisbon meets the sea. Considered to be the Portuguese Riviera, Estoril and Cascais are full of glamour and charisma. They offer a great diversity of attractions and the experiences in a limited area and in a setting that is exceptional in terms of nature, culture and heritage along the whole of this marvellous coast.

Sintra is an inexhaustible attraction. The perfect symbiosis between nature and its man made heritage led to its UNESCO World Heritage status in the Cultural Landscape category in 1995. The town has been adored over the years by artists and writers from all over the world. The passion for the town reached its peak in the 19th century, in the heart of the romantic era. Poets such as Lord Byron, who called it a "a Garden of the Earthly Paradise", and Portuguese writers such as Eça de Queiroz, who described it in many passages of his works, helped create a special aura of the town.

Setúbal/Tróia : The Costa Azul has a wide natural diversity of landscapes and environments, favoured by the presence of the sea, and is a wonderful region to discover. It has a wealth of natural and cultural attractions and comprehensive modern infrastructures to ensure that you thoroughly enjoy your holidays. There's always the Sea, the Nature and Golf.

RECOMMENDED GOLF COURSES

MONTADO HOTEL & GOLF RESORT

The Golf Course of Montado can be found near the Castle of Palmela, surrounded by vineyards developed in a harmonious whole of Cork Trees, where streams and lakes make the magical beauty of this golf course. It has been carefully inserted into a landscape that helps to break the routine of daily life, and is well known for its hole 18 and green located on an island. It is just 30 minutes south of Lisbon, one of Europe's most stylish and historic capitals. After an extensive course refurbishment in 2006, Montado Hotel & Golf Resort was catapulted into the spotlight. The layout is now considered to be one of the best around Lisbon. The course is surrounded by a series of enchanting vineyards, offering a number of memorable holes as you are led to the epic 18th, where a daunting island green awaits.

QUINTA DO PERÚ & COUNTRY CLUB

With the Arrábida mountains as its backdrop, the Quinta do Perú golf course offers amateurs a pleasant game, whilst also presenting a challenge for professionals. It was voted amongst the top 10 courses in Portugal in the biennial poll organised by the European Golf magazine. With its many trees and wild flowers, the course provides a varied start, for the first three holes consist of a par 5, a 386-metre par 4 and a 186-metre par 3. Amongst the first nine holes, attention is drawn to the short eighth hole, with a lake in front of its green. The next nine holes are even more difficult. Number 12 is a par 4 which, although not very long, has a lake running beside the fairway and down to the green. Then comes what is probably the most difficult test on the course: hole 16, a 200-metre par 3, where one needs to play over a lake to reach the green. The course's recognised quality has led to its hosting several events from the European Challenge Tour.

AROIRA I

Located in a protected pine woodland, 30 minutes from central Lisbon, south of river Tagus and near to the beach. Aroeira's mild climate allows golf to be played all year long. Aroeira I was designed by Architect Frank Pennink in 1973 with a beautiful tree-lined course adorned by 5 lakes. The course is 6044 meters long and a par 72.

Apart from the quality of two 18 holes championship golf courses, Aroeira offers self catering apartments for rent, a tropical swimming pool, tennis courts and a shopping area with restaurant, supermarket among other shops.

SANTO ESTÊVÃO GOLFE

Designed by the renowned English architect Donald Steel, with a curriculum of hundreds of golf courses around the world, the Santo Estêvão Golfe represents the typical concept of the English school, taking advantage of all the features of the land, respecting and benefiting the existing landscape. This scenery is complemented by areas of natural vegetation, with the golden tones of dry herbs to contrast with the varied colours of spring flowers. An environment that enriches the Vila Nova project of Santo Estêvão making it an epitome of quality and lifestyle.

RIBAGOLFE I & II

Just you and the golf course. The Perfect Partnership on a par with the best in Europe in terms of layout, environmental features and design. It is the creation of the two golf architects Michael King and Peter Townsend, from European Golf Design, an associate of the PGA European Tour. Golf occupies only one third of the total area of the Herdade da Vargem Fresca. There are two golf courses, Ribagolfe I and Ribagolfe II, both par 72 with 18 holes. There is also a vast practice area in addition to the driving range, including chipping and putting greens, practice bunkers and a fully equipped Clubhouse with a proshop and restaurant services. Ribagolfe is on the list of candidates to host national and European competitions.

TROIA GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP COURSE

Troia Golf Championship Course is located on the Troia Peninsula. It lies on a long flat and sandy stretch of land across the Sado Estuary, which separates the Setubal lagoon from the Atlantic Ocean, with the dramatic backdrop of the Arrabida mountain range. This gem of a course, was ranked #25 amongst Europe Top 100 Courses by British magazine "Golf World". The American golf architect Robert Trent Jones Senior, achieved a real masterpiece of golf course

ESTORIL GOLF COURSE

One of Portugal's oldest and most emblematic courses, the Estoril Golf Course, is located in the residential area of Estoril, only 1 km from the Hotel Palácio, the beach of Estoril and the famous Casino.

Owned by the Hotel Palácio from 1929 and redesigned in 1936 by the famous architect Mackensie Ross, this stunning 18 hole Championship Course is a par 69 with 5175 meters, surrounded by colourful flora, including mimosas, pine and eucalyptus trees. The Portuguese Open was played 20 times, Ladies Open and 63 times the Portuguese International Championship Amateur.

Another excellent 9 hole the Blue Course, provides the perfect location for less experienced players to develop their skills.

Golf Estoril also features an elegant Clubhouse attractively situated in a pine forest setting, with a refined restaurant, 2 bars, swimming pool and Pro Shop.

Guests of the Hotel Palácio have preferential tee times and green fees at a special rate.

OITAVOS DUNES – NATURAL LINKS GOLF

Oitavos Golfe lies within the Sintra-Cascais Natural Park. It is set among pine woods and reforested dunes, in an area of great natural beauty. Being a seaside golf course, the ocean view is present all the time. The layout has been carefully crafted by one of the greatest golf architects of our times, Arthur Hills. Hills has maintained and preserved the unique characteristics of the land, creating a 6.303 metre, par 71 golf course. The environmental certification was done in cooperation with Audubon International, an American environmental association. The sustainability of the resources is the prior objective. The flora and fauna peculiar to the region are strictly protected, with some areas being closed to people and machines. Quinta da Marinha Oitavos Golfe is the 1st Golf Course in Europe and the 2nd in the World being recognized as a Certified Signature Sanctuary - Gold. It is already set as one of the best golf courses in Europe, where a non stress round of golf can be played all year round.

PESTANA BELOURA GOLF RESORT

The verdant foothills of the Sintra Mountains offer a breathtaking backdrop for the Pestana Beloura Golf Course. Here the famous American golf course architect Rocky Roquemore has conceived a course that will stretch both your imagination and ability yet provide an enjoyable challenge to golfers of all levels. Over 40,000 Eucalyptus, Oak, Pine, Magnolia, Palm and other exotic trees and plants have been planted on this gently undulating Par 72, 18 hole course that measures 5,716

design at Troia, creating a true championship layout and providing a genuine test of skill for the lower handicap golfer together with enjoyment for the more modest player. There is a nice Clubhouse, skilfully constructed in rustic style, nestling in a pine grove, with full facilities, a bar and restaurant with terrace overlooking several holes of the course and miles of unspoilt sandy beach. Accommodation is available on site at the Troia Resort.

ESTORIL/SINTRA GOLF COURSES

CLUB DE GOLF QUINTA DA MARINHA

This exciting, 18-hole course is designed by the internationally acclaimed golf architect Robert Trent Jones. A par 71 with 5,845 meters. 



premier championship parkland courses. Previously home to the Ladies Irish Open, the Seniors Irish Open and the Irish PGA Championship, the 18 holes offer golfers a wonderful variety.

The golf course at Luttrellstown Castle is a spectacular course which was designed by Tom MacKenzie and Donald Steel (whose work includes Turnberry, St Andrews and Royal St Georges), close to Dublin city and a short drive from the airport. This Par 73 is firmly established as one of Ireland's premium courses. It has a superb club-house, two excellent restaurants, a driving range, a short game area and a 3-hole short course designed to sharpen the wedge game.





And this is by no means the only top-class links course in Co Sligo. Enniscrone Golf Links, affords panoramic views of Killala Bay, Barra Island and sandy beaches with Nephin and the Ox Mountains forming the backdrop.

Castle Dargan Golf Resort is home to one of the premier parkland golf courses in the North West of Ireland. Making the most of the natural ebb and flow of the Sligo estates grounds, Darren Clarke course designer has woven eighteen beautiful golf holes through majestic trees, natural lakes, burns and around the ancient stone walls and ruins which dominate this romantic landscape.

Moving to Strandhill golf course which contains 5,804m of undulating fairways & unforgiving shortcuts, and a promise of an unforgettable experience by all who play it. The par 70 course is challenging but rewarding!

To County Mayo where you will find Ballina, Westport and Castlebar Golf Clubs. Also recommended is Carne Golf Links in North Mayo which lies in magnificent unspoiled sand dunes overlooking Blacksod Bay and the wild Atlantic. Carne is an 18-hole, par 72 and was the last links course designed by the late Eddie Hackett.

Further North into Donegal where outstanding golfing venues trip easily off the tongue. While in Donegal you should consider Donegal Golf Club at Murvagh, which is an outstanding links golf course. Designed by the legendary course architect, Eddie Hackett, it is continually featured in Golf World's Top 100 courses in Ireland.

The Abbey Hotel Donegal is renowned for its unique setting and idyllic views, situated in the centre of the beautiful and historic coastal town of Donegal, located on the banks of Donegal Bay. Surrounded by the extraordinary beauty of churches, castles, shops and monuments, the Abbey Hotel is an ideal starting point for family, leisure and business travellers. Located near beautiful coastal drives and signature discovery points, the Abbey Hotel is ideally situated for planning your golf visit to the North West.

Also the stunning links of Portsalon where golf has been played since the 1880's. Originally designed by Thompson of Portrush, the layout has evolved over the decades with significant changes being undertaken under the guidance of Pat Ruddy in 2000. Portsalon continues to progress, with the 2014 Ryder Cup captain, Paul McGinley, guiding further improvements.

Bundoran Golf Club is a challenging par 70, which sweeps along the rugged and picturesque Donegal Bay coastline with a mixture of dunes and undulating terrain making up the 18 holes.



PONTA DO PARGO IN MADEIRA TO OPEN IN 2026
